Display the Will of God in Your Actions - 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7

- I. His Will is for Sanctification (4:3-6)
 - A. Abstain from sexual immorality
 1. Flee as far away as you can
 2. Any items relating to sexual impurities
 - a) PORNEIA (GRK) - Covers several areas
 - b) Not just adultery
 - B. Manage your own bodies
 1. For the purpose of sanctification
 - a) Being set apart as children of God
 - b) Self-Control is practiced
 - (1) 2 Corinthians 3:5 - Using God for self-sufficiency
 2. For the purpose of honor
 - a) Your vessel reflects your mind about God
 - b) Being Christ like is the example to show how a son treats a father
 - C. Gentile "bad" Example
 1. Not in Passion of Lust
 - a) Lust is emphasized as a passion of the heart
 - b) The heart is deceitful - Jeremiah 17:9
 2. Not in ignorance to God

- a) Ignorance Results in lack of submission - Romans 10:3
- b) In Ignorance However, you receive mercy 1 Timothy 1:13

II. His Will Has Called Us (4:7-8)

A. Called us to cleanliness

- 1. Through Christ we are made white as snow
- 2. Directed to act accordingly, commanded

B. Called us to be Holy

- 1. Holy People - As God is - 1 Peter 1:16
- 2. None Holy Like the Lord - 1 Samuel 2:2
 - a) Importance of putting on Christ

III. His Will Can Be to Reject Us (4:8)

A. Rejection of Paul is rejection of God

- 1. Jesus commanded that we listen to the apostles
- 2. The message is from God, not Paul

B. God Provided the Holy Spirit

- 1. His Spirit can be Quenched - 1 Thessalonians 5:19
- 2. Received it when we were baptized - Acts 2:38
