

## Pathway to Level 2

- Intended for online students living in the United States that desire to complete their junior and senior years in Lubbock (1 year: August-May)
  - Students must have full support when moving to Lubbock. Classes are full-time and, students are not permitted to work during this time.
- All the online courses must be completed by August 1<sup>st</sup> of any given year to be accepted into SIBI's residential second-year class.
- Students will go through the residential application process.
- Students will remain under online studies through till graduation.
- 
- All lab classes are taken with level 2 students.
- Emphasis track is chosen prior to August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Congregational Ministry, Family & Youth, Missions, Interpretation (ASL Students), Women's Ministry
